TRANSFER CREDIT AGREEMENT
Between
REINHARDT UNIVERSITY
And
OGEECHEE TECHNICAL COLLEGE

This agreement establishes the guidelines under which students who attend Ogeechee Technical College may transfer to Reinhardt University. Both institutions agree to:

1. Maintain a Reinhardt University/Ogeechee Technical College Coordination Committee comprised of representatives from both institutions that will; (a) hold regular meetings to determine and implement a regular review cycle for the purpose of examining proposed syllabi for transferable courses, and (b) monitoring cooperative administrative processes for admission, financial aid, and academic records.
2. The Coordination Committee shall consist of the following representatives from Ogeechee Technical College: Executive Vice President for Academic Affairs; Dean for Academic Affairs; and Registrar. Reinhardt University's representatives shall consist of the following: Vice President of Academic Affairs; Dean of the School of Professional Studies; Director of Admissions and Recruitment; and Registrar.
3. Acknowledge that the Vice President and Dean for Academic Affairs at Reinhardt University is to maintain a collaborative working relationship with the Executive Vice President for Academic Affairs at Ogeechee Technical College and be administratively responsible for the oversight and coordination of this transfer program.
4. Award transfer credit from Ogeechee Technical College to Reinhardt University for the following courses with a grade of "C" or higher:

*NOTE: Reinhardt University's Pre-Calculus, Calculus I, and Calculus II courses are 4-credit hours, while Ogeechee Technical College's courses of the same title are 3-credits. Reinhardt will accept these three courses as transfer credits to satisfy math requirements, but students will only earn 3 hours of academic credit.

5. Students accepted into the Bachelor of Criminal Justice may be awarded transfer credit for completion of specific coursework at Ogeechee Technical College. Award transfer credit from Ogeechee Technical College to Reinhardt University for the following courses with a grade of "C" or higher:

6. Students transferring to Reinhardt University from Ogeechee Technical College must satisfy the admission requirements of Reinhardt University. Reinhardt University will evaluate each applicant and accept or reject the applicant based on established admission policies.
7. Any additional courses considered for transfer from Ogeechee Technical College to Reinhardt University must be reviewed for collegiate content unless specified in the Transfer Articulation Agreement between the Georgia Independent Colleges Association and the Technical College System of Georgia. This review shall be conducted by the Coordination Committee under the administrative supervision of the Vice President and Dean for Academic Affairs at Reinhardt University.
8. Ogeechee Technical College agrees to provide Reinhardt University with a list of Associate of Applied Science graduates on a recurring basis. The list shall be used by Reinhardt University exclusively in service of this Articulation Agreement.

9. Reinhardt University agrees to provide Ogeechee Technical College with an annual report on the progress of transfer student persistence toward degree attainment.

This agreement is entered into for the 2016-2017 Academic Year beginning with the commencement of Summer Semester 2017. This agreement may be amended at any time by mutual written consent of both parties. This agreement may also be cancelled at any time by either party with at least ninety (90) days written notice to the other party. If this agreement is cancelled, Ogeechee Technical College and Reinhardt University will work together to ensure that students currently applying at Reinhardt University will have an opportunity to transfer their courses.
