Enrollment & Student Populations

Ogeechee Technical College enrolled 3,057 students in credit courses during Academic Year 2022.

This was the full-time equivalent (FTE) of 1,610 students (based on the sum of total credit hours for all students). The College's Student Retention Rate is 67.1% of first-time, regular-admitted students enrolled in Fall 2020, who graduated or were still enrolled in a Georgia college/university or National Clearinghouse college as of the end of the next year (AY 22).


